

Kellsie's Hope Foundation Nursing Scholarship

Open to pediatric oncology staff member, who meet the criteria below:

- 1. Pediatric Oncology staff who are pursuing a nursing degree
- 2. Pediatric Oncology nurses who are pursuing a graduate degree
- 3. Pediatric Oncology nurses who wish to attend an accredited conference or workshop related to the care of Pediatric Oncology Patients.

This scholarship will be awarded annually in the amount of \$1,000

This scholarship honors Kellsie Marchbanks, who was a pediatric oncology patient at Children's Hospital. She was diagnosed with Osteosarcoma at age 15 and during her hospital stays; she developed a passion to become a Pediatric Oncology Nurse. She hoped to be able to use her experience as a patient, to make a difference in the lives of the children she would be caring for. Unfortunately, she relapsed just 2 weeks after she began Nursing School at Goldfarb School of Nursing and passed away on June 8, 2011, at age 20. The kind and compassionate staff at Children's became like family to Kellsie and her family.

Kellsie never gave up HOPE and was always making plans to find ways to help others. She wanted to give back, and Kellsie's Hope Foundation continues her legacy of giving. Giving to children who have cancer and their families through wishes, raising funds for pediatric cancer research, which stays in the St. Louis area and giving to the nursing profession through an annual scholarship to a student from the high school she attended that is pursuing a nursing career, and an annual scholarship to Pediatric Oncology Staff at Children's Hospital, who were so near and dear to her heart and now is giving annual national nursing scholarships as well.

Applications will be evaluated by Kellsie's Hope Foundation Advisory Board. Final decisions about scholarship selection and award amount are the responsibility of Kellsie's Hope Scholarship Committee.
